### **School Timings:**

School begins at 8:30am although gates are open to all children from 8:25am. 100% attendance is essential for pupils to meet Year 2 ARE/Age Related Expectations, and punctuality contributes to this as every minute is a learning minute! The end of the day is at 3.15pm. Please ensure that your child is collected on time at the end of the school day.

### **PE:**

PE is every Tuesday. Pupils should come to school in their PE kit on PE days.

**Uniform reminder:** please ensure that all clothing items, including PE kits are **clearly labelled** so pupils are able to find them easier.

**Times Tables:** Children should know their 2,5 and 10 times tables.

**Reading:** It is important that you are read with your child **every day**. Pupils have been given a **reading record and reading book** to take home **daily**. Pupils must return their reading record and reading book into school daily, with their reading record **signed by a parent/carer** as proof of having read at home. This is an essential part of your child's development and we thank you in advance for your continual support.

**Homework:** Children will be given a pages to complete in their CGP books; please ensure that all tasks set are completed to a high standard. Activities set for your child to complete will be mentioned on the online learning platform called 'Seesaw' on Fridays. Children should have completed it by the following Wednesday for marking. Logins will be provided.
